O R D E R

1. This Transfer Petition is filed by Smt.Renu @ Sita Kishorkumar Yaganani against her husband Kishorkumar Narayandas Yaganani. By our order dated 01.07.2013, we had directed the parties to appear before the Supreme Court Mediation Centre, since both the learned counsel for the parties had stated that there is every possibility of arriving at an amicable settlement of the dispute between themselves.

2. The learned Mediator, after mediating between the parties, has sent a report along with the settlement agreement reached between both the parties. The report of the learned Mediator is taken on record.

3. One of the clauses in the settlement agreement is that the parties would file an appropriate petition as envisaged under Section 13(1)(B) of the Hindu Marriage Act before the Family Court, Ajmer, Rajasthan for grant of mutual decree of divorce. In view of the aforesaid clause, we now direct both the parties to jointly file such an application before the Family Court, Ajmer, Rajasthan for

grant of appropriate relief(s) as expeditiously as possible, at any rate, within an outer limit of two months' from today.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the respondent, as per the terms of the settlement agreement has handed over a demand draft for a sum of Rs.5 lacs to the learned counsel of the petitioner and the same is acknowledged by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. In view of the above, we are of the opinion that as of now nothing survives in this Transfer Petition for our consideration and decision.

6. The Transfer Petition is disposed of accordingly.
