O R D E R

This petition is filed by the wife for transfer of
petition for dissolution of marriage filed by the husband
under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending on
the file of Civil Judge, Senior Division, Mathura (U.P.) to
the Court of competent jurisdiction in Delhi. Petitioner
alleges that she is residing in Delhi; that her mother is
chronic heart patient; that the petitioner apprehends that
she may be assaulted at Mathura by the respondent and that
there is no one to accompany her to Mathura to defend her
case. Though she is an advocate, no advocate is willing to
appear on her behalf at Mathura on account of influence by

her husband who is an advocate at Mathura.

2. The respondent has denied the allegations. However,  
on the facts and circumstances, we consider this a fit case  
for transfer.

3. Accordingly, transfer petition is allowed.
