O R D E R

Delay condoned.

We have heard learned counsel for the respective
parties.

It is submitted at the bar that the petitioner-
accused has married the second respondent "so-called
victim" on 23.11.2025 and that the impugned order was
passed prior to the date of marriage. In the circumstances,

the impugned order may be set aside and the relief of suspension of sentence and bail may be granted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner also submitted that having regard to the fact that the parties are since married, this Court in exercise of its powers under Article 142 of the Constitution of India and may quash the FIR, the conviction and the sentence if deemed appropriate.

We take note of the aforesaid submissions.

In the circumstances, we direct that the petitioner herein shall be released on interim bail and direct as under:

"The petitioner shall be produced before the concerned Sessions Court as early as possible and the Sessions Court shall release him on interim bail for a period of four weeks from today, subject to such conditions as it may deem appropriate to impose to ensure his presence in the proceedings arising out of FIR No.129/2022 mentioned above."
