We find no material to support the submission urged on behalf of the petitioner that the two trials have been amalgamated. All that is stated in ground (VII) is that both the cases are now been tried by the same Magistrate. No doubt, the High Court has observed that the Court may consider amalgamating the two cases. That is a matter which the Trial Court has to consider having regard to the nature of the two cases. The Trial Court in its discretion may or may not amalgamate the two cases after considering all relevant material on record.
