UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. The short grievance of the petitioner is that Criminal Miscellaneous CRM-M-66193/2025 (O&M), filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 read with Section 44 of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act, 2002, has been 'admitted' by the High Court of Punjab and Haryana vide impugned order dated 20.01.2026, however, the same is ordered to be heard within one year.

2. We have heard Shri Balbir Singh, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner.

3. It seems to us that, owing to the nature of the relief sought by the petitioner, the High Court ought to have decided the petition, preferably at the motion stage. There was hardly any necessity to admit the same.

4. Be that as it may, the petitioner may move an application before the High Court along with a copy of this order, whereupon the Registry of the High Court is directed to list the application along with the main case for final hearing after obtaining necessary orders from Hon'ble the Chief Justice of the High Court. The Bench, to whom the case will be entrusted, is requested to decide the main case within three months.

5. It is stated that the petitioner will request the CBI Court for deferment of trial. We express no opinion in that regard. The said Court will take an appropriate decision in accordance with law.

6. The Special Leave Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

7. All pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
