O R D E R

1. The petitioner challenges the judgment and order dated 31.12.2025 in CRMM No.74068/2025 titled "*Somesh Agrawal vs. State of Haryana*" passed by the High Court of Punjab & Haryana at Chandigarh.
2. Issue notice, returnable on 23.03.2026.

4. Let counter affidavit be filed within two weeks. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within one week thereafter.

7. Needless to add, the petitioner would maintain good conduct and not attempt to influence any of the witnesses, in any manner, till the completion of the trial.
