UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

With the consent of the parties, the matter is taken up for final disposal.

We direct that the respondents shall be permitted to harvest the crops in the presence of the petitioner or his representatives. An officer to be nominated by the High Court shall be present at the time of harvesting. The mere fact that the harvesting is being permitted to be done by the respondents

shall not be considered to be a favour when the matter is taken up by the High Court while dealing with the writ appeal pending before it. We are told that the appeal is fixed for hearing on 13.4.2005. Let the hearing be taken up on that date subject to the convenience of the Bench hearing it and the matter may be disposed of as early as practicable. After the harvesting is done, status quo regarding possession shall be maintained till the disposal of the writ appeal by the High Court.

The special leave petition is disposed of accordingly.
