Heard counsel for the petitioner. The petition is delayed by 142 3 days. We

are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order. However, the counsel for the

petitioner points out that in the last paragraph of the judgment of the Sessions Court it was observed that the petitioner would not be entitled to the benefit of Section 428 of Cr.P.C.. We make it clear that the said direction of the Sessions Judge will not stand in the way of any remission to be passed in favour of the petitioner. We also notice that there was no specific direction to run the sentences concurrently. We make it clear that the sentence imposed on the petitioner on various counts would be read as to run concurrently. With the above modification, the petition is disposed of.
