O R D E R

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner invites our attention to the order dated 17.10.2025 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Track Court (Page 89) whereby the parents of the instant petitioner, who were co-accused, have been acquitted.

2. Further, our attention is invited to the Certificate dated 03.10.2016 (Page 35) issued by the Commandant 141 BN BSF under

whom the instant petitioner was posted, that as on the date of occurrence of the alleged incident, the petitioner was on duty posted on the Indo-Bangladesh Border which place perhaps is far off from the place of the occurrence of the incident.

3. Issue notice, returnable on 02.04.2026.

4. Dasti service, in addition, is permitted. Let steps for service be taken within one week.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) is permitted to serve the learned standing counsel for the State of Uttar Pradesh.

6. In the notice itself let it be mentioned that respondents are required to file their counter affidavit and reply to the interlocutory application(s), if any, before the next date of listing.

7. In the meanwhile, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner.

8. Till the next date of listing, further proceedings in relation to FIR/ Crime No.227 of 2016 dated 13.06.2016, registered at Police Station Inchauli, District-Meerut, shall remain stayed.
