We have heard Mr. S.K. Bhattacharya, learned counsel
for the petitioner.

We reiterate as already been stated by the High
Court in the impugned order that the transit camps proposed
to be set up in Anand Parbat to relocate the slum dwellers
of Kathputli Colony are purely a temporary measure for a

period of two years and no permanent features shall be
attached thereto. Obviously, respondent Nos. 3 and 4 - Delhi
Development Authority and the Commissioner have to ensure
that nothing is done by them inconsistent and contrary to
the above observations.
