After having gone through the earlier order dated  
23.1.2012 in Writ Petition No.1158/2012, passed by learned  
Single Judge of the High Court of Madhya Pradesh at  
Jabalpur, wherein learned Single Judge had fixed the Time  
Table for recording of the evidence of the parties and the
