O R D E R

Delay condoned.

After hearing learned senior counsel for the petitioners, we do not find that any case is made out for

interference with the impugned order passed by the High Court. The Special Leave Petition is accordingly dismissed.

However, as requested by the learned senior counsel for the petitioners, we grant time to the petitioners to vacate the premises in dispute and hand over vacant physical possession thereof to the respondents-landlords on or before 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2026 subject to clearance of arrears of rent within one month and also payment of charges for use and occupation of the premises at the same rate in advance for each month. It is subject to the petitioners filing an unconditional undertaking on oath before this Court within a period of four weeks from today to vacate the subject premises as per the above terms.

On failure to comply with the terms of the aforesaid undertaking, the respondents shall be entitled to initiate proceedings for contempt in addition to any other remedy available to them.

Pending applications shall also stand disposed of.
