UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. The petitioner has been denied anticipatory bail by the High Court in connection with First Information Report bearing No.02 of 2026 registered with Sector 19 Police Station, Chandigarh for the

offence punishable under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, "The IPC").

2. We heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, the learned counsel appearing for the State and the learned counsel appearing for the complainant.

3. We are informed that the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

4. Having regard to the nature of the allegations and the business relations between the parties, we are of the view that the petitioner has been able to make out a case for grant of anticipatory bail.

5. In the result, we direct that in the event of arrest of the petitioner in connection with the offence, referred to above, he shall be released on bail by the Investigating Officer, subject to terms and conditions that he may deem fit to impose.

6. Once the petitioner is released on anticipatory bail, the petitioner shall thereafter appear before the Trial Court and furnish fresh bail bonds.

7. With the aforesaid, this petition stands disposed of.

8. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
