The respondent-husband has filed a petition seeking
restitution of conjugal rights at Chandrapur, Maharashtra,
but the petitioner/wife has sought a transfer of this
matter to her parental home at Gorakhpur, where she has
already filed a petition before the Family Court, Gorakhpur
seeking maintenance. This Court had rejected her transfer
petition as the petitioner on the one hand has been

claiming maintenance but on the other hand is resisting the proceedings of her husband seeking restitution of conjugal rights.

The petitioner has now filed this review petition reiterating her prayer for transferring the aforesaid case for restitution of conjugal rights from Maharashtra to Gorakhpur and has practically reiterated her submissions
