O R D E R

In view of the undertaking given by the respondents herein to the effect that they would

demolish the structures raised by them and furthermore in view of the fact that the High Court has

noticed that the said respondents had completed the construction of the first floor and moreover the

construction of the second floor had been going on, we are of the opinion that it is not a fit case where

we should exercise our jurisdiction under Article 136 of the Constitution of India. However,

keeping in

view the facts and circumstances of this case, we would request the trial Court to expedite the hearing of

the Suit and dispose of the same as early as possible preferably within a period of six months from the

date of receipt of this order.

With the aforementioned observations, the special leave petition is dismissed.
