UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.

2. The petitioner has been denied anticipatory bail by the High Court in connection with FIR No.273 dated 30.12.2021 registered with Police Station Mataur, District S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali under Sections 417, 419, 468, 471 and 120-(B) of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short,"the IPC"), respectively.

3. Heard Mr. Vikas Verma, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr. Kapil Balwani, the learned counsel appearing for the respondent/State.

4. Having regard to the fact that the petitioner is a young lady, aged 31 years and also considering the nature of the accusations, we order that in the event of her arrest in connection with the offence enumerated above, she shall be released on anticipatory bail subject to terms and conditions that the Investigating Officer (I.O.) may deem fit to impose.

5. Once the petitioner is released by the I.O on bail, she shall thereafter appear before the territorial Trial Court and furnish fresh bail bonds.

6. With the aforesaid, the Special Leave Petition stands disposed of.

7. Pending application(s), if any, stand disposed of.
