

Court of Judicature at Patna.

3. The appellant was arrested in connection with Crime No.95 OF 2024 registered at Narhiya Police Station, Madhubani District, Bihar.

4. It is stated that the counter affidavit dated 06.05.2026 has been filed on behalf of respondent no.01/State, but the same is not on record. The said affidavit is handed over across the Bar and is taken on record.

5. Having heard learned counsel for the parties, and perused the material placed on record, we are of the considered view that the appellant has made out a case for interference with the impugned order dated 03.12.2025.

6. Considering the totality of

circumstances and also the fact that the appellant has been in custody since 29.04.2025, we are inclined to grant bail to the appellant on such terms as may be fixed by the Trial Court. Ordered accordingly.

7. To comply with this order, the appellant shall be produced before the Trial Court forthwith.

8. Trial expedited. The appellant shall fully cooperate during the investigation/trial, and he shall not misuse the liberty in any manner, and shall extend complete cooperation in the trial of the instant case. It shall be open to the Trial Court to take all steps, including cancellation of bail, should the necessity arise.

9. Needless to add, if the investigation is not complete in all respects, the appellant would fully cooperate, and if the challan/charge sheet is filed, he would maintain good conduct and not attempt to influence any of the witnesses in any manner till the completion of the trial.

10. If the appellant possesses a passport, the same shall be surrendered before the Competent Authority/Court until the conclusion of the trial or directed otherwise.

11. The impugned judgment/order dated 03.12.2025 shall stand set aside.

12. Accordingly, the appeal is allowed.

13. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
