O R D E R

The L P A has been dismissed on the ground that this is too small a matter. The issue is whether the first respondent who is required to officiate as Chief Engineer for a period of about two years is entitled only to officiating allowance or salary to the higher post.

As observed by the High Court as the amount involved may not be much we do not propose to interfere in the proceedings under Article 13 6 . The issue is, however, left open. The special leave petition is dismissed.
