O R D E R

This order disposes of two petitions filed for transfer of cases, pending at Mathura, to Alwar . One petition pertains to transfer of suit No. 700 of 2001 titled as Satendra Singh Advocat

e vs. Smt.Babli @ Shashi Kanta pending in the Court of Civil Judge Senior Division Court No. 1 Mathura to the Court of District Judge Alwar, Rajasthan. it is a case

filed by the Responent-husband for a decree of divorce against the petitioner. The other petition pertains to three criminal cases, namely Case No. 1009/2002, case No.795/2002 and Criminal Complaint Case No. 931/2002 which are pending in Court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate Court No.4 Mathura. In all these cases the husband-respondent in this petition in the complainant and father of the petitioner Navab Singh & another are the accused.

Both parties allege influence of the other in their own district and place. During the course of hearing both the parties are agreed to transfer of all the cases being transferred to the appropriate courts in Delhi. That being the position, we dispose of the above noted two transfer petitions by ordering transfer of Case No. 700 of 2001 titled as Satendra Singh Advocate vs. Smt. Babli @ Shashi Kanta, pending in the Court of Civil Judge, Senior Division Mathura, to the Family Court at Delhi.

The other three Criminal cases, Case No. 1009/2002, State of U.P. Vs. Nawab & Ors., Case No. 795/2002, State of U.P. Vs. Nawab & Ors. and Criminal Complaint Case No. 931/2002 titled as Satendra Singh Vs. Navab Singh and Anr., all pending in the Court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate Court No. 4, Mathura are transferred to the Court of CMM Delhi who may

either retain these cases in his court or transfer them to any other competent court of Metropolitan Magistrate.

Both the petitions are allowed and disposed of in the manner indicated above.
