O R D E R

In view of the allegations and counter allegations made in the transfer petition, we are of the opinion that the ends of justice would be subserved if Mat. Pet. No.2/2005 titled N.Anand Vs.Anureka is transferred from the Family Court at Dehradun to the District Court/Family Court at Palghat, Kerala. The Family Court at Dehradun shall send the records to the Court of District Judge/ Family Court at Palghat, Kerala. If there is no Family Court at Palghat, the District Judge shall either dispose of the matter himself or transfer the same to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

The transferee Court shall issue notice to the parties after fixing a date of hearing. Having regard to the fact that both the parties are from different States, we would request the concerned Court to accommodate them as far as possible. Furthermore, in view of the fact

that the respondent is now

posted at Assam, we would request the concerned Court to consider the desirability of disposing of the matter as expeditiously as possible and preferably by hearing the matter on day to day basis.

The transfer petition is allowed accordingly with the aforementioned observations and directions. No costs.
