that the date of the Memorandum of Understanding annexed to the Award has been erroneously

petitioner has no grievance whatsoever against the Award other than this grievance and that he

had moved an application under Section 152 Civil Procedure Code for correction of the date of

the Memorandum of Understanding annexed to the Award, but his application was dismissed on

the ground of pendency of Special Leave Petition (C.) No. 8954/2005.

If this is the only grievance, we see no reason to interfere in the present petition. The

Special Leave Petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to move the High Court after
