O R D E R

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that initially when the injured was examined, no grievous injury was pointed out. Only pain in different parts of the body was there.

However, the injured got a CT Scan done from a hospital without informing the Police. The report suggests undisplaced fracture of bilateral nasal bones with overlying soft tissue swelling.

Subsequently, a board was constituted to examine the injury which had reiterated the fact that at the time of initial examination, no injury or bleeding was found on the nose.

Ms. Abha Sharma, learned advocate appearing through video conference, accepted notice for the respondent-State.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer in connection with FIR No.159 dated 21.11.2025 registered at Police Station - City-1 Mansa, District Mansa, Punjab.
