UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Heard Mr. B. Karunakaran, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.
2. Issue notice, returnable on 20th July, 2026.
3. Mr. B. Karunakaran, learned counsel submits that if family members of the deceased can be impleaded, an appropriate order for compensation can be made.
4. Liberty to implead the family members of the deceased.
5. Liberty to amend the memo of parties after impleading the legal heirs of the deceased.
6. Let service be effected on the newly impleaded parties

through the Inspector of Police, Gurubarapalli Police Station, Krishnagiri District, Tamil Nadu.

7. Liberty to serve the Standing Counsel for the State of Tamil Nadu.

8. The petitioner had already exempted from surrendering by an order dated 13.03.2026, however, the exemption is till the first date of listing of the matter.

9. The order granting exemption shall continue subject to the petitioner appearing before the Trial Court concerned and executing a bond for Rupees Fifteen thousand with two sureties of the like amount.

10. Let an affidavit of compliance be filed before this Court within a period of two weeks.
