O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. It is an admitted fact that the petitioners' appeal against the order dated 25.07.2025 is pending consideration before the statutory authority. In the meanwhile, respondent no. 5 applied for demarcation of scheduled land for carrying out road construction and stone and murram quarry and the Naib Tehsildar passed an order dated 03.10.2025 directing demarcation. The petitioners, instead of filing an appeal against the said order,

approached the High Court under Article 226 of the Constitution, which came to be dismissed by the order impugned before us.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, we permit the petitioners appeal against the order dated 03.10.2025, and the said appeal can be heard along with the other connected matter and disposed of expeditiously, preferably within three months from the date of filing of the appeal.

4. With these observations, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.
