O R D E R

1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The petitioner has been denied bail in Crime No.271 of 2025 under the provisions of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act, 1985 registered at Police Station-Rampur Baghelan, District Satna, Madhya Pradesh. It is alleged that 345 bottles of Onerex/Onrex cough syrup were recovered from the vehicle driven by the

petitioner. The petitioner was arrested on 23.04.2025. One of the independent witnesses to the seizure has turned hostile. Out of the 12 witnesses, only three have been examined so far.

3. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, we consider it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on bail subject to such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Trial Court.

4. The Special Leave Petition stands disposed of accordingly. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
