**UPON hearing the counsel  
the Court made the following  
O R D E R**

1) Against an order of rejection of regular bail by the High Court and to seek bail, the present special leave petition has been filed. The petitioner is in custody w.e.f.26.07.2025 in connection with FIR No.323 of 2025 dated 23.07.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 80(2) and 85 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, and Sections 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition

Act, 1961, registered with Police Station Sector 113, NOIDA, District Gautam Budh Nagar.

2) Having heard learned counsel for the parties and on perusal of the material so placed before us and in the facts and circumstances of the case wherein the husband himself has brought the deceased to the hospital for admission though in unconscious state, at present, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, we deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on bail.

3) Accordingly, we direct to release the petitioner on bail on furnishing the suitable bail bonds and sureties and on such other terms

and conditions as may be deemed fit by the trial Court.

4) Petitioner to abide all the conditions as imposed and shall regularly attend the trial until exempted by the Court. Violation, if any, may give a cause to take recourse as permissible and the trial Court is at liberty to do the needful.

5) Accordingly, and in view of the foregoing, the special leave petition stands allowed. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
