UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

- (i) Against an order of rejection of regular bail by the High Court and to seek bail, the present special leave petition has been filed. The petitioner is in custody from 20.05.2025 in connection with FIR No. 85/2025 dated 15.05.2025, for the offences punishable under Sections 22 and 29 of The Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered with Police Station Puruwala, District

Sirmaur, Himachal Pradesh.

(ii) After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that quantity is intermediate and looking to the fact that the petitioner is licensee of the shop. However, at present, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, we deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on bail.

(iii) Accordingly, we direct to release the petitioner on bail on furnishing the suitable bail bonds and sureties and on such other terms and conditions as may be deemed fit by the trial Court.

(iv) Petitioner to abide all the conditions as imposed and shall regularly attend the trial until exempted by the Court. Violation, if any, may give a cause to take recourse as permissible and the trial Court is at liberty to do the needful.

(v) Accordingly, and in view of the foregoing, the special leave petition stands allowed. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
