



of 2001 which was supported by the affidavit of the advocate Mr.Narayan K.Iyer, it is stated on oath that he has sent the certified copy to the concerned advocate in the month of April, 1999. In view of these two contradictory statements and on the facts of this case, we are not satisfied that the delay in filing of this S.L.P. has been properly explained. On the contrary, the petitioners have tried to make out a false case to seek the condonation of delay. There is no cause let alone sufficient cause to condone inordinate delay of 717 days. The application for condonation of delay is therefore dismissed. Consequently, the special leave petition is also dismissed.
