UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Application for exemption from filing certified copy of the impugned judgment is allowed.

2. The prayer made in the present petition is for grant of pre-arrest bail in connection with FIR No.294 of 2024 dated 7<sup>th</sup> July, 2024 registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, Punjab. Initially, the offences as alleged in the FIR were under Sections 323 and 341 of the Indian Penal Code, 1908 (for short, "the IPC"). The offences being bailable, the petitioner was released on bail by the Trial Court vide order dated 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2024. Subsequently, after three months, the offences under Section 406 and 498-A of the IPC were also added. The prayer is for grant of pre-arrest bail for the added offences.

3. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable on 2<sup>nd</sup> April, 2026.

4. Ms.Baani Khanna, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent No.1-State.

5. Let service on respondent No.2 be effected on taking appropriate steps by the petitioner.

6. In the meantime, in the event of arrest in connection with the FIR mentioned aforesaid, the petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. Needless to add that the petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation.
