O R D E R

The challenge in this petition is to an interim order dated 28th March, 2005, passed in Writ Petition No.44930 of 2004, whereby it was

directed that the petitioner shall be placed under suspension forthwith.

Now, the said writ petition has been finally disposed of by the High Court in terms of Order dated 30th May, 2005 in K.S. Suryanarayana vs. State of Karnataka, reported in I.L.R. 2005 Karnataka 3625. In view of the disposal of the writ petition by the High Court, the present petition filed against the interim order has become infructuous. The petitioner would, however, be free to challenge in accordance with law the final order passed in the writ petition by the High Court. The said challenge, if made, would be examined on its own merits without being influenced by the disposal of this petition filed against the interim order.
