This is a petition filed by the wife against the respondent- husband seeking transfer of matrimonial proceedings initiated by the respondent-husband at Delhi to a competent Court in Jammu.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the respondent has no objection to concede to the prayer for transfer provided the proceedings are expeditiously disposed and not delayed.

In view of the stand so taken by the learned counsel for the respondent, the prayer for transfer is allowed. H.M.A. No. 566/97 pending in the Court of Addl.
