UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The petitioner and co-accused - *Tushar* are facing trial
for commission of offence under Section 302/34 of Indian

Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25, 27, 54 and 59 of the Arms Act, 1959.

2. The petitioner is in jail since 06.02.2020. Similarly placed co-accused - *Tushar* who was also in jail from the same date, has been released on bail by the High Court *vide* order dated 08.04.2026 in bail application No. 540 of 2026.

3. In the counter affidavit filed in this Special Leave Petition it is stated in paras (I.9 and I.10) which is reproduced hereunder:

9. That witness Mohini, in her statement recorded during investigation, disclosed that on 05.02.2020, she had received a phone call from the Petitioner Sumit, who told her that he, along with his cousin Tushar @ Aniket, had fired upon Gagandeep, and further threatened that he would also kill Mohini.

10. That during investigation, the accused persons, namely Sumit (present Petitioner) and Tushar @ Aniket, were arrested on 06.02.2020 at the instance of witness Mohini. During interrogation, it was revealed that the Petitioner, along with co-accused Tushar @ Aniket, had procured two country-made pistols and that on 04.02.2020, both of them had fired one bullet each at Gagandeep with the intention to kill him.

4. In view of the above, considering release of co-accused *Tushar* on bail by the High Court and the length of pre-trial detention of the petitioner also, we are inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

5. Accordingly, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of,

directing that the petitioner be released on bail on such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Trial Court in connection with FIR No. 66 of 2020 registered at Police Station - Janakpuri, Delhi for the offence punishable under Section 302/34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25, 27, 54 and 59 of the Arms Act, 1959, subject to petitioner's co-operating with the trial.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
