UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

After hearing both the sides at some length, the prayer for bail is rejected. Mr. Sushil

Kumar, learned senior counsel, however, contended that patient is suffering from diseases like

Lumba Disc Prolapse, Cervical Spondylosis, Systematic Hyper Tension and he needs Ayurvedic

treatment like ulichal, pizhichal and Thokkanam. As against this Mr.KTS Tulsi, learned senior

counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents submits a sheet of medical report in which it is

found from page 129 Vol.II Additional Documents that Ayurvedic treatment has been provided

but the patient is not taking Ayurvedic medicine and not willing to be examined by Ayurvedic

Doctor. The report is dated 4th July,2005 to 31st July,2005. From the report it appears that

patient was examined from 4th July.05 to 31st July,2005. On every day patient has refused to

take Ayurvedic medicine and Ayurvedic oil application prescribed by the Aringar Anna Govt.

Indian Medicine Hospital experts and patient has also refused examination by the expert.

Having regard to the report submitted by the respondent, we do not think necessary to

issue any direction. The Special Leave Petition is dismissed.

W.P.(Crl.) No. 204/05

In view of the dismissal of the SLP(Crl.) No. 2140/05 this petition does not survive. The

Writ Petition is dismissed accordingly.
