The petitioner herein has assailed the order passed by the High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan at Jaipur Bench by which the the High Court has refused to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

It appears that the petitioner is accused of the offence under Sections 420, 406 & 120-B I.P.C. and is alleged to be involved in a case of cheating giving rise to a scam involving crores of rupees by fabricating sale deeds and misusing the name of the cooperative society.

The petitioner, under the circumstance is directed to file a fresh application for grant of bail before the Trial Court and the Trial Court may consider the bail application of the petitioner in the light of the material collected at the stage of investigation that has been made in regard to the F.I.R. lodged against the petitioner. Subject to this liberty, the special leave petition is dismissed.
