O R D E R

1. This Transfer Petition is filed by the petitioner-wife under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure read with Order XXXVI-B of the Supreme Court Rules, 1966, seeking transfer of H.M.A. No.289 of 2012, titled as "Gaurav Singh vs. Mansi Singh", pending before the Court of learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Dwarka, New Delhi to the Court of Competent Jurisdiction, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh.

2. During the pendency of this petition, by our order dated 11.11.2013 we had directed the parties to appear before the Supreme Court Mediation Centre in order to explore the possibility to reach at an amicable settlement.

4. In view of the Settlement Agreement between the parties, we are of the opinion, that nothing survives in this Transfer Petition for our consideration and decision. Accordingly, the Transfer Petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.

5. However, we direct both the parties to adhere to all the terms and conditions envisaged in the Settlement Agreement.
