O R D E R

1. Application, IA No. 46971/2026, seeking deletion of respondent no.3 from the array of parties is allowed at the risk and request of the petitioners. Amended memo of parties be filed within one week.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners would draw the attention of the Court to the additional documents filed by the petitioners in the present Special Leave Petition wherein, by an order dated 09.01.2025, the Second Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Bengaluru, has granted divorce to respondent no.2 and her husband, who is the son of petitioner no.1. Thus, according to the learned counsel for the petitioners, when the complainant has settled her matrimonial dispute with the main accused i.e., her husband, the petitioners should should not be dragged in contesting the proceedings arising out of the FIR which is lodged against them.

3. Issue notice on the Special Leave Petition as also on the application (IA No. 46969/2026) seeking condonation of delay, returnable in six weeks.

4. In the meanwhile, further proceedings before the Trial Court shall remain stayed.
