This transfer petition has been filed by petitioner-wife seeking transfer of Petition No. 418A/11 filed by the husband-respondent under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 in the Family Court at Raipur (Chhattisgarh) to the Family Court at Bhopal (Madhya Pradesh).

2. Notice of the transfer petition has been issued to the respondent. Despite service of notice, the respondent has not chosen to appear. The facts stated in the transfer petition thus remain untraversed and uncontroverted.

3. Having regard to the fact that the petitioner-wife resides at Bhopal, we are satisfied that if the above case is allowed to be continued at Raipur (Chhattisgarh), greater hardship shall be caused to the petitioner-wife.

4. We, accordingly, allow this transfer petition and transfer Petition No. 418A/11 pending before the Family TRANSFER PETITION (CIVIL.) NO(s). 386 OF 2012

Court at Raipur (Chhattisgarh) to the Family Court at Bhopal (Madhya Pradesh). The Family Court at Raipur (Chhattisgarh) shall transmit the entire record and proceedings of the above transferred case to the Family Court at Bhopal (Madhya Pradesh) without any delay.
