The petitioner has lodged FIR No.136 for the offence punishable under Section 363 read with 34 IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar on 19-8-1996. Despite various orders passed by the High Court as well as Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar directing proper investigation in the aforesaid case, Investigating Officers are not in position to get clue with regard to the forcible abduction of petitioner's minor son aged about five years, for more than four years. Hence, the petitioner has filed this petition under Article 136 praying that CBI be directed to investigate the same.
