O R D E R

In the course of submissions, Mr. Dushyant Dave, learned senior counsel for the petitioners, submitted that the petitioners shall pay to the respondent No. 2 (second defendant) the value of the property described in Schedule AA at the guideline value fixed by the Government

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as on the date of compromise deed as provided in clause

(xiii) in the Memorandum of Settlement.

Let the executing court determine the value of the land in terms of clause (xiii) of the Memorandum of Settlement as expeditiously as may be possible. The petitioners shall pay the amount so determined within eight

weeks from the date of determination by the executing court.

If any amount has been paid as per the agreement to the respondent No. 2, the same shall be adjusted in the amount that may be determined by the executing court.

Special leave petition is dismissed with the above observations.
