O R D E R

The learned counsel for the parties submitted that the parties have settled the dispute and a compromise deed is also executed indicating the terms of settlement. According to the settlement, O.P. No. 85 of 2003, titled as Sanjay Kumar Agarwal vs. Rochika Agarwal, pending in the Family Court, City Civil Court at Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh may be transferred to the court of the District Judge at Delhi so that the parties may take necessary steps to act in terms of the compromise deed. In this view of the matter, as requested by both the learned counsel for the parties, we order transfer of O.P. No. 85 of 2003, titled as Sanjay Kumar Agarwal vs. Rochika Agarwal, pending in the Family Court, City Civil Court at Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh, to the court to District Judge at Delhi, who may either try the case himself or transfer it to a court of competent jurisdiction.
