The learned counsel for the petitioner, drawing our attention
to
an order dated 6th July, 2000, passed by the High Court fixing maintenance
pendente lite at the rate of Rupees two thousand per month, submits that the
said amount of maintenance was fixed both for the wife and the daugh
ter

but the daughter was married way back in August, 2001, but the petitioner learnt about it much later during the proceedings. The petitioner may bring this fact to the notice of the High Court and seek modification of the impugned order which application would be considered on its own merits.

Be that as it may, on 9th November, 2002, this Court, while remitting F.A.O. No.17-M of 1999, had expressed the hope that the appeal would be decided by the High Court expeditiously. The appeal in this matrimonial matter has been pending in the High Court for nearly seven years. We are told that the petitioner has even retired from service. The appeal shall be disposed of expeditiously within a period of three months from today.

The special leave petition is disposed of accordingly.
