O R D E R

This petition is directed against order dated 12.12.2011 passed by the Division Bench of the Bombay High Court, Nagpur Bench whereby the Letters Patent Appeal filed by the petitioner against an interim order passed by the learned Single Judge directing him to pay a sum of Rs.25,000/- per month to the appellant as maintenance for herself and the minor child was dismissed.

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner

for some time and perused the record. In our considered view, the Division Bench of the High Court did not commit any error by refusing to interfere with the order of the learned Single Judge, who reduced the amount of maintenance awarded by the Family Court, Nagpur from Rs.50,000/- to Rs.25,000/- per month.

The special leave petition is accordingly

dismissed. While dismissing the special leave petition we make it clear that it will be open to the respondent to make an application to the learned Single Judge for enhancing the amount of maintenance.
