ORDER

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Questioning the correctness of the order passed by the High Court, Jabalpur Bench, dismissing the writ petition filed by the appellant, this appeal has been filed.

The background facts in a nutshell are as follows:-

The respondent was engaged as boatman for certain days every year. The Labour Court was of the view that respondent has worked for more than 242 days. The materials in this regard is scanty. However, considering the peculiar facts of this case and taking note of the Order dated 29.5.2005, we direct the respondent who has been reinstated on 26.5.2001 shall be paid 50% of the back wages from the date of termination till the date of reinstatement which is stated to be, as noted above, 26.5.2001. It is stated by the learned counsel for the State that 25% of the amount pursuant to the order dated 29.5.2005 has already been deposited and withdrawn by the respondent. The balance amount shall be deposited within a period of two months from today.

The Appeal is accordingly disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
