OFFICE REPORT

The matter above-mentioned was listed before the Hon'ble Court on 15th March, 2013, when the Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

"Issue notice, confined to the question as to whether the bike of the petitioner, which was seized, may be released to him on payment of adequate security.

Issue notice also on the petition for condonation of delay."

Accordingly, show cause notice was issued to the sole respondent(State) through registered A.D. Post.

It is submitted that neither A.D. Card nor unserved cover containing show cause notice has been received back. As the service of show cause notice was incomplete, the matter was listed before the Registrar Court from time to time and as per Registrar Court's order dated 31.08.2015, the matter above-mentioned was lastly listed before the Hon'ble Judge-in-chambers on 4th July, 2016, when His Lordship was pleased to pass the following order:-

"Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that today he shall comply with the objections raised by the Registry.

He is also permitted to serve a copy of the petition to the standing counsel.

Registry to verify and proceed further accordingly."

It is submitted that Counsel for the petitioner has filed proof of service and Mr. M.Yogesh Kanna, Advocate has filed vakalatnama/appearance on behalf of sole respondent.

Service of show cause notice is complete.

The matter above mentioned is therefore listed before the Hon'ble Court with this Office Report.
