granted time to the present respondent for vacating the premises in question. From a bare perusal of the file, it would appear that there was no order either for eviction or recovery of possession when the special leave petition was disposed of by this Court. It appears that under some confusion, prayer for time was made and granted to vacate the premises in question. Accordingly, that portion of the order dated 8th December, 2006, passed in S.L.P. (C) No.12814 of 2005, granting time to the petitioner to vacate is recalled. The order dismissing the special leave petition is, however, maintained. To the aforesaid extent only order dated 8 th December, 2006, stands modified. In view of this, the contempt petition and interlocutory application are dismissed.
