UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. The main Appeal preferred by the Castle Vista Pvt. Limited came to be dismissed on the ground of delay.
2. The Order passed by this Court dated 17-5-2024 reads thus:-  
*"1 There is a delay of 376 days in filing the appeal.*  
*2 The argument of the appellant is that the respondent had filed a review petition before the National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission (NCDRC) which was pending. This does not constitute sufficient ground for the appellant not to challenge the order of the NCDRC within time.*  
*3 Consequently, we are of the view that the civil appeal should be dismissed only on the ground of delay.*  
*4 The Civil Appeal is accordingly dismissed on the ground of delay."*

3. Today, we have an Office Report before us bringing it to our notice that an amount of Rs.50,000/- was deposited by the appellant in terms of the proviso added to Section 23 of the Consumer Protection Act, 1986 by the Consumer Protection (Amendment) Act, 2002 in the Suitor's fund account.

4. We direct that this amount of Rs.50,000/- shall be disbursed in favour of the Respondent No.1. We order accordingly.

5. To enable the Registry to disburse the amount of Rs.50,000/-, we grant two weeks' time to the learned counsel appearing for the Respondent No.1 to furnish the necessary Bank account details of the Respondent No.1 to the Registry.

6. With the aforesaid, the Miscellaneous Application stands disposed of.
