UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Although we have not been entertaining similar writ petitions, as any direction issued in such like matters would amount to direct interference in the roster management of the Hon'ble Chief Justice of the High Court, having regard to the fact that (i) first petitioner's husband has died during the pendency of the case before the Motor Accident Claim Tribunal; (ii) the liability on the petitioner(s) and surviving family members is sought to be fastened only on the ground that the motorcycle belong to the deceased husband of the first petitioner; and, (iii) there appears to be no insurance policy which had been obtained, we are satisfied that the case bearing Writ-C No. 32980/2024 deserves to be heard on out of turn basis.

2. We, therefore, request the Hon'ble Chief Justice of the High Court to post this matter as Item No. 1 before any appropriate Bench in the week commencing 16.03.2026.

3. The writ petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
