O R D E R

The only ground on which the High Court has allowed the W.P. in favour of the respondents is that the petitioners attempt to deny family pension to the parents of the deceased employee on the basis of Rule 4 (ii) of the Family Pension Scheme 1964 which Rule had earlier been struck down by the same court.. In impugning the decision of the High Court, the petitioner Nigam has not thought it necessary to challenge this statement of fact nor has

it taken any ground that the observation of the High Court is incorrect in any fashion nor has any copy of the Family Pension Scheme 1964 been annexed. We see no reason in the circumstances to interfere with the decision of the High Court. The SLP is accordingly dismissed.
