O R D E R

1. Leave granted.
2. I.A. No.63156 of 2026 has been jointly filed by the parties seeking appropriate directions under Article 142 of the Constitution of India for dissolving their marriage.

decree of divorce by mutual consent;

ii) All the legal proceedings pending *inter se* the parties, if any, shall stand closed;

iii) Decree be drawn up accordingly;

6. In view of the above facts, I.A. No.63156 of 2026 is allowed and the appeals stand disposed of.
