Leave granted.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, we are of the opinion that the appellant should be released on anticipatory bail in the event of he being arrested. Therefore, we direct the trial court or the arresting authority, as the case may be, to release the appellants on bail on his furnishing self bond in the sum of

Rs.25,000/- with two sureties for the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting authority/trial court as the case may be.

The appellants shall abide by the conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) of the Criminal Procedure Code.

In addition to the above conditions required under Section 438(2) the appellant shall give his specimen signature if required by the Investigating Agency.

The appeal is allowed.
